Children can experience both short and long term cognitive, behavioural and emotional effects as a result of witnessing domestic abuse. Each child will respond differently to trauma and some may be resilient and not exhibit any negative effects. Children's responses to the trauma of witnessing domestic violence may vary according to a multitude of factors including age, race, sex and stage of development.
